

**Competition prices 2024/25**  
(Excluding French Championships)

Text to be kept, Form to be signed (last page) and must be returned to the office before any entry / participation in the competition season 2024/25 (valid from 01/09/24).

CSO : Concours de Saut d'Obstacle (Show Jumping Competition)

TDA: Tournée des As (high standard show circuit pony competitions over a full weekend)

French National Championships: Our riders have been representing Belle Ferme at the National Pony Championships each year consecutively since 1994 at Lamotte Beuvron! Classes exist in many different levels and equestrian disciplines. All pony competitions (both normal and TDA's) have a system of points earned towards possible participation according to results.

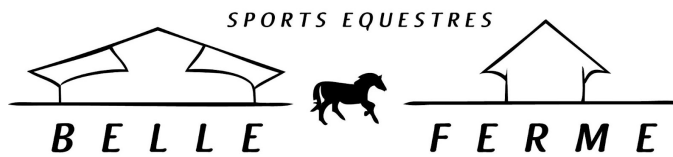
Participation at Belle Ferme or local competitions can be done on riding school horses and ponies. To participate in TDA's and Championships, one needs to either own or rent a pony, or we offer a Demi Pension Plus which enables 2 riders to share one pony. *Our riding school horses and ponies cannot go to TDA's.*

**Requirements:** Valid FFE licence with up to date Competition Licence. Minimum level Galop 2 validated with the FFE. *We recommend you take out your 'next year's' licence in November or December to have time to renew these so as not to be caught out for January shows!*

**To make a show entry:** Mostly, entries close at the FFE at midnight on the Monday before the competition. *After this date/time, it is impossible to cancel or add an entry.* Some competitions choose to accept "Engagement Terrain", which are entries that can be done on the competition day, but the price is fixed (also by the FFE) at 3 times the normal price. (This never exists for dressage). A change of horse or rider remains possible after the closing date.

***The deadline for signing up in the office at Belle Ferme is 5pm on Saturday, 8 days before the competition,*** due to the fact that there's no one in the office to take or do entries on Sundays or Mondays. A fee of 6 euros per entry will be charged for any entry forgotten or changed after 5pm on the Saturday (8 days before).

It is imperative that you go to the office and sign up on the appropriate sheet the rider, the horse and the class in the "competition" folder. You must also have the prior agreement of your instructor concerning both level/height and pony/horse. It goes without saying that the parents of minors must agree and be informed.



A pony can do a maximum of 3 rounds in a day, we cannot guarantee the pony you want. The coach can modify any sign up that he considers unsuitable for the rider or the pony. *It is not possible to register by e-mail, telephone, message, telling your instructor or any other means than in the folder.* Riders are strongly advised to check for themselves on the FFE website (my rider page) before the closing date (Monday preceding the show) that the entree is correct. In the event of an error or oversight on our part, please contact us immediately.

**Equine accommodation** : Boxes (if needed) per horse according to the organiser's rates; approximately 100 euros (straw/shavings) to be paid at the time of booking, well before the competition. If Shavings are needed they must be bought by the rider and are not available at Belle Ferme.. Count on about 10 euros/horse for hay for a weekend. *Boxes reserved can in general not be refunded either.*

**Riders Accommodation:** Food and accommodation are at the expense of the rider according to their own organisation. **MinWarning:** Competitions accept a limited number of participants. Due to this, some shows; basically all TDA's now are full within a few minutes after opening ! This year, even the organiser is not allowed to add as many riders as they chose. We do our best to enter all our riders, but **we can not guarantee to get all the places we need.** *Championships are not limited.*

#### **Fees :**

**Entries.** This varies according to the club and discipline (approx. 25e per class). Part of this sum goes to the organising club and part to the FFE. After the closing date one week before the show this is not refundable.

**Coaching** (Dressage and Cso): One hour is deducted from the card per rider and per event. This is a fixed price and does not depend on the time spent on the horse. It applies even if the classes follow each other and there is only one warm up. This is also the case if two riders are riding the same horse. Riders are under the responsibility of their parents outside of the classes and training with the instructor.

**Instructor & administrative costs.** See the table below. This is once per rider and does not take into account the number of horses per rider and corresponds to covering the instructors costs; accommodation, meals, administrative costs - organisation of bookings etc. For less than 3 riders and for '\*': accommodation and meal costs must be covered.

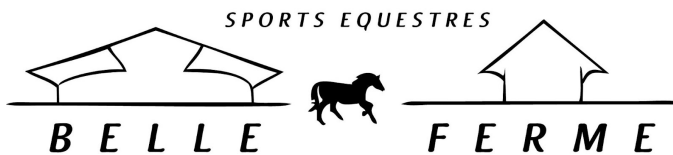

NB : These prices can be modified to follow the increases of fuel costs.

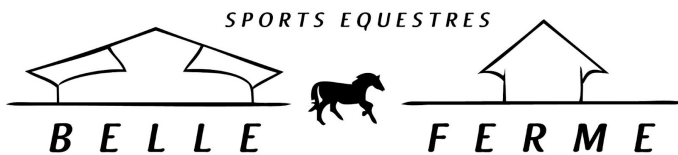
#### What to expect?

This involves extremely clean ponies/horses, clean tack and equipment, long hair tied back, clean boots and correctly fitting smart competition clothes. *This involves time at BF the evening before to prepare all this.*

Riders representing Belle Ferme are also expected to show irreproachable behavior and respect towards all involved; their horses, coaches, parents, other competitors be it Belle Ferme riders or others, jury etc.

We also expect BF riders (and ideally parents) to be available to join us with a great team spirit to help setting up the course (Saturday afternoon) and or putting away at the end of the day. Of course any other help during the day or beforehand is much appreciated! For this, we have a WhatsApp group to give times and information about the shows.

We also recommend that you support Belle Ferme and show your team spirit by wearing our Belle Ferme clothing for all events, both riders and accompanying adults!
